Fig-1: Annual Inflation Rate

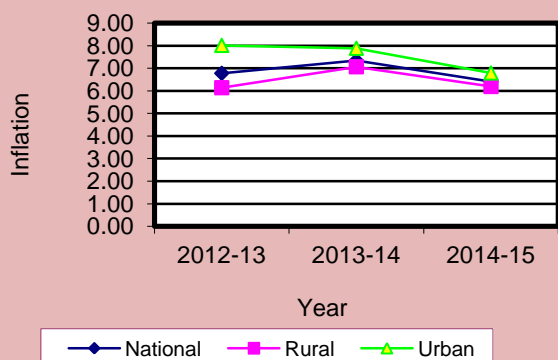


Fig-2: Monthly Inflation Rate

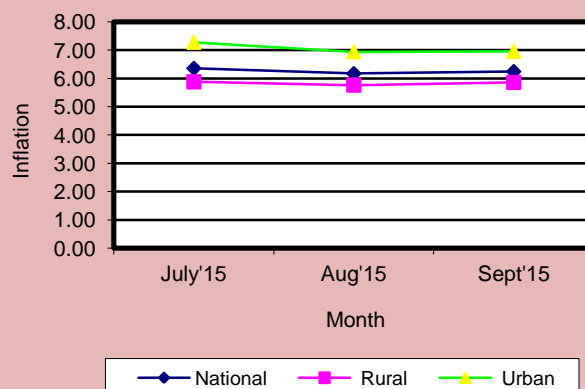
