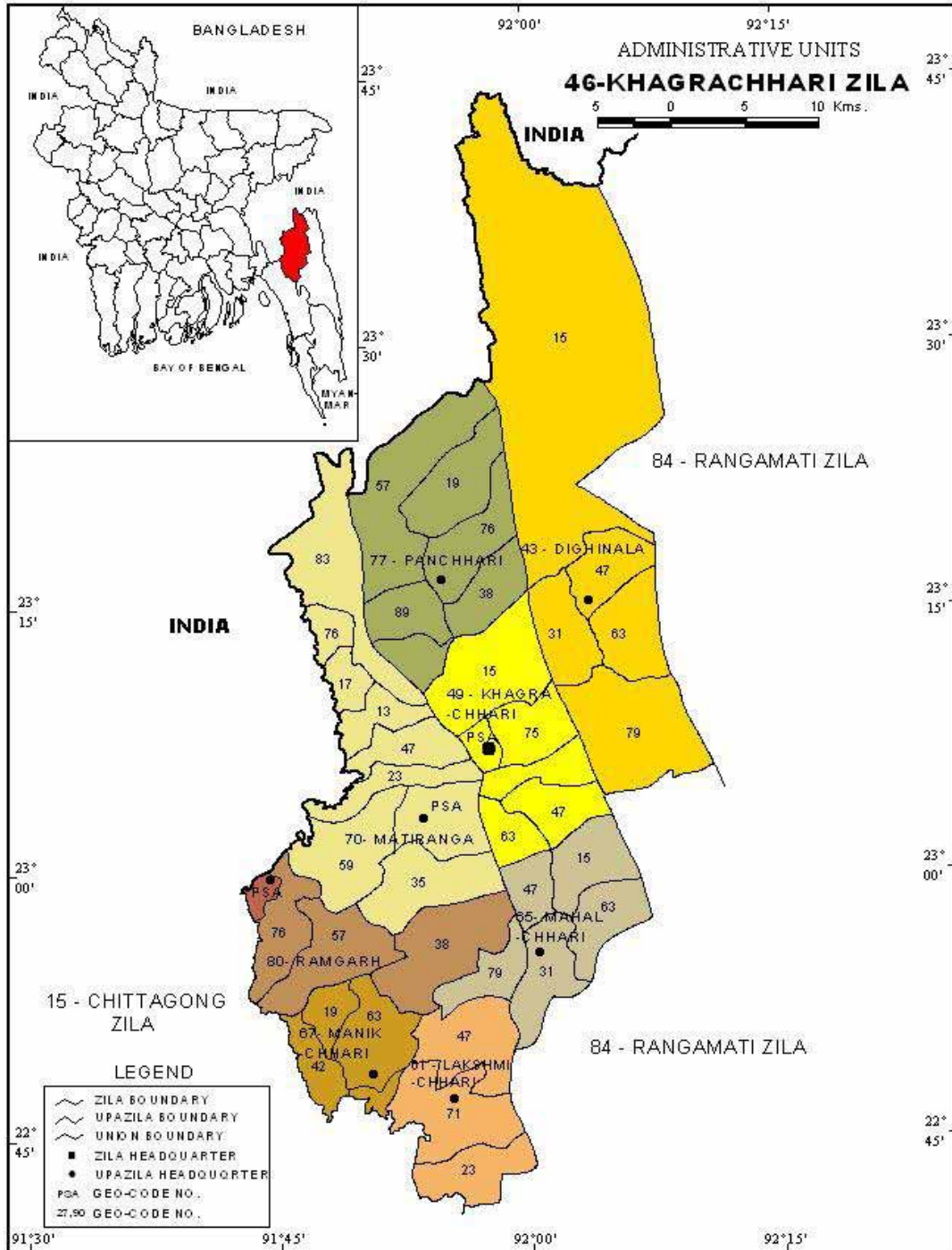

# **CHAPTER 1**

## **Introduction**



## District at a Glance

**Background:** Khagrachhari was formerly only a union under Mahalchari Thana in Ramgarh sub-division of Chittagong Hill Tracts district. It became Thana in 1968. The Headquarter of Ramgarh sub-division was situated at Ramgarh previously. The Ramgarh sub-division shifted to Khagrachhari in 1970 and was upgraded to a district in 1983. Nothing is definitely known about the origin of the district name. It is said that the existing district headquarters is situated on the bank Chengi of the Khagrachhari stream (chhara) which was full of Catkin plants. Catkin plants mean 'Khagra' in local languages. The popular view says the district name of Khagrachhari was originated from 'Khagra'.

**Geographic Area and Location:** Khagrachhari is bounded on the north by India, on the south by Chittagong and Rangamati districts and on the west by India and Chittagong district. It lies between 22°38' and 23°44' north latitudes and between 91°44' and 92°11' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 2,699.55 sq. km (1042.30 sq. miles) of which 603.73 sq. km is under forest. It is a hilly district. The hills of this region are composed of folded sedimentary rocks. Notable hill areas are Alu Tilla and Bhanga Mura. Total area of Khagrachhari district is 2699.55 sq.km.

**Administration:** Khagrachhari sub-division was turned into a district 1<sup>st</sup> November, 1983. The district Chittagong Hill Tracts was established in 1860 under the 'Frontier Tribes Act 22 of 1860'. Following the district of Chittagong Hill Tract Regulation Act, the Chittagong Hill Tracts was divided into three sub-divisions (included Khagrachhari) in 1900. The Khagrachhari Local Government Council was formed in 1989 (in accordance with the Khagrachhari Hill districts Council, Act 20), which on the basis of the historic 'Chittagong Hill Tracts Peace Accord' was turned into Khagrachhari Hill District Council on 2 December, 1997. The district consists of 8 Upazilas, 38 unions, 120 mauzas, 1706 villages (paras), 3 paurashavas, 27 wards and 155 mahallas. The Upazilas are Dighinala, Khagrachhari Sadar, Lakshmichari, Mahalchari, Manikchari, Matiranga, Panchari and Rangarh.

**Historical Events:** The Chittagong Hill Tracts was under the region of the Tripura State and governed by the Arakans and the Sultans in different times. It became under the control of the British East India Company in 1760. Although the British got the authority of the Chittagong Hill Tracts in 1760, they had no authority besides collecting nominal taxes. Until 1860, two kings/chiefs governed the internal administration of this region. In 1860, another 'circle' was formed inhabited by the Tripura population in present Khagrachhari district. The chief/ the Raja of this circle was selected from the minority Marma population. The 'circle' was named after the Tripura dialect the 'Mun Circle'. Later, the 'Mun dialect', was changed and renamed as 'Mong Circle'. In 1900, the British offered autonomy status to Chittagong Hill Tracts recognizing the culture and language of the Hill Tracts population. But during the Pakistan period, this status was abolished, which created anger among the Hill Tracts population. Moreover, due to the construction of the Kapat Dam in 1960, thousands people became homeless and refugee. As consequences, the hill population revolted claiming autonomy. This problem was resolved by the Chittagong Hill Tracts Peace Accord on 2 December, 1997.

**Temperature and Rainfall:** The annual average temperature of the district varies from maximum 34.6°C to minimum 13°C and the average annual rainfall of the district is 3031 mm.

**Archaeological Heritage and Relics:** Archaeological heritages are Rajbari of the Mong and Dighee of Dighinala (excavated by Gobinda Manikyo exiled king of Tripura in 1664).

**Marks of the War of Liberation:** There are 1 Mass grave, 1 Memorial plank and 2 memorials in this district.

**Educational Institutions:** The number of educational institution are College 7, high school 58, junior high school 38, Government Primary School 320, Non-government Primary School 156, kindergarten 9, vocational school 2 and madrasa 44.

**Educational Institutions:** Noted educational institutions of this district are Khagrachhari Government College, Khagrachhari Mahila College, Khagrachhari Government High School, Khagrachhari Government Girl's High School and Ramgarh Government Degree College.

**Locally Published Newspapers and Periodicals:** Locally published newspapers and periodicals are Daily Arany Barta, Weekly Parboti, etc.

**Cultural Organization:** Public Library 1, Khudra Niri-Gofthir Sanskritc Institute, Shishu Academy, Shilpakala Academy, Womens Organization-29 and many other social organization.

**Main Rivers:** Chengi, Maini, Feni and Lake Mataipukhiri (Debota pukur) are main rivers of this district.

**Main crops:** Paddy, corn, ginger, turmeric are main crops of this district. Extinct or nearly extinct crops are Maiguro, Maibedi, Sanki, Manoful, Chikon Kuichari and Maime.

**Main fruits:** Papaya, pineapple, jackfruit, banana, mango, batabi labu (Shaddock), litchi, coconut, lemon etc are main fruits of this district.

**Traditional Transport:** Horse carriage and boat are traditional transport found in this district.

**Manufacturing Factories:** Manufacturing factories are Rubber processing plant, rice mill, flour mill, sawmill etc.

**Hats, Bazars and Fairs:** Total number of hats and bazars are 47 and noted fairs are Jur Maram Shiva Mela, Dighinala Shiva Mela, Matipukhiri Mela(Chitra Sankranti), Ayodhya Bauddha Mela, Durga Puja, Ras Mela and Ratha Jatra.

**Main Export Items:** Rubber, cotton fabrics, ginger, turmeric, pineapple, wood, banana, jackfruit etc are main export items of this district.

**NGO Activities:** Operationally important NGOs are Brac, Proshika, Anando, STEP, IDF, FPAB, YWCA, SAP, Trinomul, Pazoriko, Kabidang, Padokshep, Alo, HWA, RSS, ICPA, PBM, Green Vally, Marvibal, TLA, Parbatta Buddhists Mission and Anathalya.

**Health Centres:** The total numbers of health centre are District sadar hospital 1, Upazila health Complex 8, Family planning centre 26, Union health centre 26, Child and maternal centre 3.

**Economic Situation:** The economy of Khagrachhari district is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 116,475 holdings of the district, 89,333 (76.70%) holdings are farms and remaining 23.30% are non-farms. Despite the growth of agriculture activities, the non-farm holdings play an important role for the district. Farm-holdings produce varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables,

spices, cash crops, pulses, oilseeds, maize and others. Various fruits like banana, jackfruits, guava, coconut, etc are grown. Fishes of various species are caught from rivers, tributary channels and creeks and from paddy fields during rainy season. Besides crops livestock, hunting and fishery are the main sources of household income. The district is very rich in forest resources. Valuable timber and other forest trees are grown in the district.

There are a variety of non-farm activities in the district. The following table-1 shows total establishments and Person engaged by sex and activity in the district.

According to the table, there are 13,870 establishments in the district where 39,287 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. It is around 7% of total population of the district. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 8.40% females as against 91.60% males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity (52.58%) with 7293 establishments. Males and females engaged in the sector are 16,314 (41.53%) and 697 (1.77%) persons respectively. The second highest establishment of activities is the manufacturing, numbering 1843, which engage 5,326 persons and numbers of males and females are 4,500 persons & 826 persons respectively.

### **Flora and Fauna**

**Flora:** The flora and fauna of Khagrachhari district are largely similar to those of adjoining district of Chittagong Hill Tracts region. The flora of this region shows a considerable admixture of Cachar and Khasia elements.

The forest of Khagrachhari district may be broadly classified into: (i) tropical evergreen, (ii) semi-evergreen and (iii) deciduous types. The last type is always mixed with the evergreen species. Besides, additional undergrowth comprising bamboo brakes and Savannah is also included in the forest

composition of the district. All these forests generally consist of three stories.

The upper storey ranges from 100,150 feet in height and is usually composed of trees like chapalish (*Artocarpus chapalish*), telsur (*Hopea odorata*), chandul (*Tetrameles nudiflora*), narikelis (*Sterculia alata*), civit (*Swintonia floribunda*), garjan (*Dapterocarpus turbinatus*), karoï (*Albizia procera*), banderhola (*Duabanga sonneratoïdes*), champa (*Michelia champaca*), shimul (*Bombax ceiba*), chikrasi (*Chukrassia tabularies*) etc. The second storet is formed by trees such as pitraj (*Aphanamixls polystachia*), negeswar (*Mesua nagassarium*), toon (*Toona ciliata*), tali (*Dichopsis polyantha*), kamdeb (*Callophylum polyanthum*), raktan (*Laphopetalum fimbriatum*), khoirjam (*Syzygium cymosa*), gutgutia (*Bursera serrata*) and others. The third storey consists of such growth as kamini (*Murraya paniculata*), horina (*Vitex peduncularis*), jarul (*Legerstroemia speciosa*), chhatim (*Alstonia scholaris*) and the like.

Bamboo brakes are not regarded as a separate type of forests. Most commonly, they form the undergrowth under various forest types. They occupy large areas, the common species being muli (*Melocanna bambusoides*), mitenga (*Bambusa tulda*), dalu (*Teinostachyum dulooa*), barua (*Dendrocalamus longipathus*), etc. Besides, some cane brakes like kerak, gallak, jaitabeth, etc. are also found in the moister localities.

There is a profusion of creepers, climbers, lianas and epiphytes consisting of ferns, mosses and orchids in these forests. Due to shifting cultivation (Jhum) large areas have been denuded of tree cover and usually such areas are taken over by Savannah type of forests such as shon grass (*Imperata arundinacea*), kansh (*Saccharum sponteneum*), sungrass (*Imperata cylindrica*), khagra (*Phragmites karka*), etc.

Some exotic plants such as rubber, mahogany, teak, pine etc. have also been introduced in this district.

The major agricultural crops produced in this district are rice, wheat, maize, vegetables, pulses, oilseeds, spices, tobacco, cotton, etc. Most common horticultural crops are banana (*Musa sapientum*), pine apple (*Ananas comosus*), cashewnut, guava (*Psidium guajava*) and papaya (*Carica papaya*). The homestead flora includes a wide variety of trees, shrubs and the undergrowth. Roadside trees are mahogoni (*Swietenia macrophylla*), leak or shal (*Shorea robusta*), devdaru (*Polyalathia longifolia*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), katbadam (*Terminalia catappa*), arjun (*Terminalia arjuna*), etc.

## Fauna

**Mammals:** The forests of Khagrachhari like those of other hill districts of Chittagong Hill Tracts region are the natural habitat for many different species of beasts, birds, reptiles, amphibians and insects.

Of primates, there are monkeys, gibbon and lemur. The rhesus monkey (*Macaca mullata*) is fairly common. The curious slow loris (*Nycticebus coucang*), a lemur, is found in the densest forests of the district. Of wild cattle (*Felis chaus*), the bon-goru (*Bos gaurus*), the goru or asian bison (*Bos pourus*) are now almost extinct. But the bon chagal (*Capricornis summatraenss*) is rarely seen in the forests. Of the carnivora, the leopapard (*Panthera pardus*), the leppard cat (*Prionailurus bengalensis*), the couded leopard (*Neofelis nebulosa*) are seen.

Other mammals that are found in these forests include ruru deer (*Muntiacus muntiac*), sambar (*Cervus duvauceli*), pati shial (*Canis aureus*), bengal fox (*Vulpes bengalensis*), bon kutta (*Cuon alpinus*), buno shukar (*Sus scrofa*), honey badger, hog badger (*Arctonyx collaris*), etc. Besides, different species of squirrels (*Callasciurus pygerytsrus*), rats (*Rattus ruttus*), mice and porcupines are also found. A large

number of bats (*Pteropus giganteus*) including Indian fruit bats are commonly seen.

**Birds:** Khagrachhari is one of the few hill districts that support the typically tropical evergreen forest species of birds. It possesses very rich avifauna. Several species of pigeons (*Copsycus-saularis*) and doves (*Streptopelia orientalis*) including horial (*Treron spicauda*), botkol (*Treron phoenicoptera*), dhumkol (*Ducula badia*), ghugu (*Streptopella orientalis*), raj ghugu (*Streptopelia senegalensis*), etc. are found. Among parakeet, tia or parrot (*Psittacula krameri*), tuta (*Psittacula kramerealis*), lalmatha tia (*Psittacula roseata*), kalomatha tia (*Pesttacula finschii*) and lejkata tia (*Loriculus vernalis*) are fairly common.

Cuckoos include lalpakha kokil (*Clamator coromandus*), bau-katha-kaopakhi (*Cuculus micropterus*), emerald cuckoo (*Chalcites maculatus*), emerald cuckoo (*Chalcities*), kalo kokil (*Eudynamis scolopacea*), banded bay cuckoo (*Cacomantis sonneratii*) and sirkeer cuckoo (*Taccocua Ieschenaultii*). Also found are different species of pheasants and quails including pahari titar (*Arborophila rufogularis*), kat mayur (*Polyplectorn bicalcaratum*), ban murog (*Gallus gallus*), bans titar (*Bambusicola fytchii*), kalo mayur (*Lophura Ieucomelana*), manipur bush quail (*Perdicula manipuriensis*) and blue breasted quail (*Coturnix chinensis*).

Several species of owls like laxmi pencha (*Tyto alba*), grass owl (*Tyto capensis*), bhutum pencha (*Bubo zeylonensis*), hutum pencha (*Bubo bubo*), khuruley pencha (*Athene brama*) and kupokh (*Ninox scutulata*) are common.

Some species of Kingfishers that are frequently seen are pied kingfisher (*Ceryle lugubris*), buno machranga (*Ceyx eerithacus*), lal machranga (*Halcyon coromandra*), machranga (*Alcedo atthis*), blackcapped kingfisher (*Halcyon chloris*) and biyth's kingfisher (*Alcedo hercules*). Among the woodpeckers (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), blacknaped green woodpecker (*Picus canus*), himalyan goldbacked woodpecker (*Dynopium javanense*), paleheaded woodpecker (*Gecinulus grantia*), small yellownaped woodpecker (*Picus chlorolophus*), dhusar matha baman kaththokra (*Picoides canicapillus*), lai khudey kaththokra (*Sasia ochracea*), etc. are common.

Among bulbuls, kalo bulbul (*Pycnonotus atriceps*), sipahi bulbul (*Pycnonotus jocosus*), bulbuli (*Pycnonotus cafer*) and jolpai bulbul (*Hypispetes viridescens*) are commonly seen. The widely found drongoes are greater rocket-tailed drongo (*Dicrurus paradisenus*), lesser rocket-tailed drongo (*Dicrurus paradiseus*), lesser rocket-tailed drongo (*Dicrurus remifer*) and hairycrested drongo (*Dicrurus hottentotus*). Birds like babblers, flycatchers and warblers are found. Mynas (*Gracula religiosa autra*), magpies (*Copsycus-s-saularis*), minuets, sunbirds and flower peckers are also found. Spider hunter, several munias, finches are met with. Among water birds, little grebe, cormorants, herons, storks are fairly common.

Besides, a large number of other birds such as raptorial birds, rails, crakes including moorhen, waterhen (*Oriolus xanthornus*), several species of charadriidae, nightjar, different species of swifts, hornbills, barbets, broadbills, larks swallows (*Hirundo rustica*), etc. are also found in these forests.

**Reptiles and Amphibians:** Reptiles that are biquitous in the Khagrachhari forest area are pahari kasim (*Manouria emya*), halud pahari kasim (*Indotestudo elongata*), raj gokhra (*Ophiophagus hannah*), shankhini shap (*Bungarus caeruleus*), ajagar (*Python molurus*), kalkeotey (*Bungarus fasciatus*), dhaman (*Ptyes korros*), anjon (*Riopa albopunctata*), tokkhak (*Gekko geeko*), kalo gui (*Varnus salvator*), etc.

The amphibians are represented by kuno frog (*Bufo melanostictus*), kokoti frog (*Rana cynaphyctis*) and gecho frog (*Rhacophorus maculatus*).

**Fishes:** Different varieties of fresh water fishes that are commonly found in Khagrachhari include ruhi or salmon (*Labeo rohita*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalbous (*Labeo calbasu*), katla or carp (*Catla catla*), etc. Soal fish (*Channa striatus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), scorpion-fish or singi are also found in large quantity in beels and khals. Many other species of river and fresh water fishes are also found in the district. Of these the principal varieties are boal/sheat fish (*Wallago attu*), dhain, chital (*Notopterus chitala*), ghonia (*Labeo gonius*), airh (*Mystus aor*), bagair (*Bagarius yarrellii*), pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*), rita (*Rita rita*), bain or eel (*Mastacembelus armatus*), chapila (*Gudusia chapra*), golsa, tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chanda (*Mene muculata*), kachki (*Corica soborna*), baila (*Glossogobius giuris*), bheda (*Nandus nandus*), batashi (*Pseuboueropiis atherinodes*), gulsha (*Mystacalalus*), kakila (*Strogylura Strogylura*), phalli or flat fish (*Notopterus notopterus*), tatkeni (*Crosscheilus latius*), pabda or butter fish (*Ompok pabda*), chela (*Chela cachius*), gangchela, gajal (*Channa marulius*), koi or climbing fish (*Anabas testudineus*), kholisha (*Colisa fasciatus*), puti (*Barbus puntius*), sharputi (*Puntius sarana*), taki (*Channa punctatus*), walking fish (*Ophicephalus striatus*), malandi, bashpata (*Danio devario*), tengra, kakra (*Scylla serrata*), meani, shrimps, and prawn are found in the district. However, some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.



## Concepts and Definitions

### 1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

#### Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

#### Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

#### Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

## Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

**i) City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

**ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

## 2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). The year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

### Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels or fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

### Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

### **Non-farm holdings**

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

### **Tenancy**

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

### **Agriculture work**

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

### **Area under pond**

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

### **Area under temporary crops**

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

### **Area under permanent crops**

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

### **Current fallow**

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

### **Net cultivated area**

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

### **Permanent fallow**

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

### **Irrigated area**

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

### **Cattle and Buffalo**

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

### **Goats and Sheep**

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

### **Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons**

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

### **Temporary crops gross area**

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

### **Intensity of cropping**

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

### **Cereals**

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

### **Pulses**

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

### **Oil seeds**

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

### **Vegetables**

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

### **Cash crop**

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.
