Fig-1: Annual Inflation Rate\

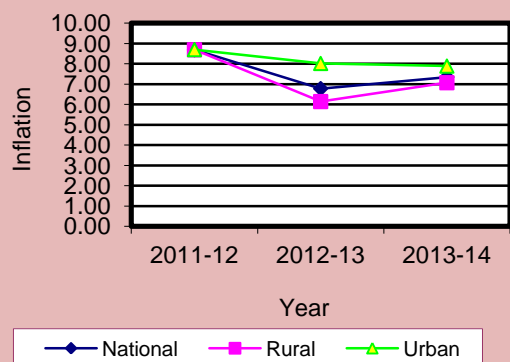


Fig-2: Monthly Inflation Rate

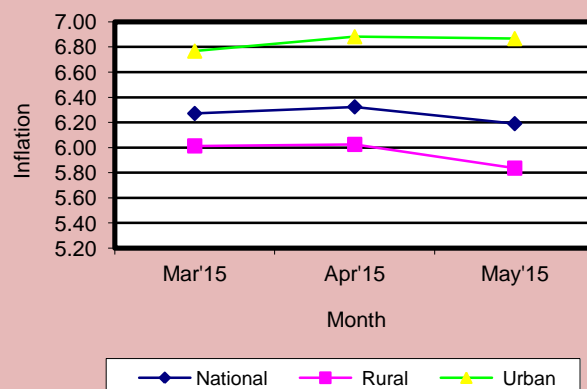
